The Chase Center

Opening in August 2019, Chase Center will be a world-class sports and entertainment destination and a new focal point for San Francisco. Here are some of our new favorites that have popped up recently.



Academy Museum of Motion Pictures

A new gateway to the Miracle Mile, Los Angeles's premiere 'movie museum' finally opens. The dome, constructed from 700,000lbs of glass and steel by Renzo Piano, will host film screenings in a lower-level theatre. Meanwhile, the expansive gallery space will show immersive exhibitions about the evolution of film that bring together key objects from the Museum's collections and an array of multi-screen presentations.

1 Hotel West Hollywood

Playing off the hues of the Hollywood Hills, the San Gabriel Mountains and the ocean, the luxe minimalism will allow the floor-to-ceiling West Hollywood views to shine through.
